

# eMBDS Evaluation Policy

## ECTS

For each exam of a specific course, if the obtained grade is beyond average (grade >50) the student gets 3 ECTS.

## GPA

All evaluations must be graded out of 100. At the end of the exam period, the final grade for each student is sent to the course leader. The GPA which appears on the transcript, is calculated based on all grades earned during eMBDS program degree. If a course is retaken, only the latest grade is taken into account.

## GPA FOR AN INTERNATIONAL STUDENT

For International students, they obtained their results in the form of letters from A to F corresponding to the following table.

<b>Grade out of 100%</b>	<b>Grade Letter</b>
90% - 100%	A
80% - 89%	B
70% - 79%	C
60% - 69%	D
50% - 59%	E
<50%	F

The result obtained in the form of a letter is subsequently converted into a numerical value in the calculation of the GPA.

<b>Grade Letter</b>	<b>GPA</b>
A	4
B	3

C	2
D	1
F	0

## **GPA FOR A FRENCH STUDENT**

The equivalence between the French and American grades is difficult to establish because the American results ranging from 14 to 20 are all grouped under the letter A. This actually means that students in the United States are evaluated on a scale that ranges from 1 to 14.

The French students match their results with the grading using the following table.
